

About Camp Somerset



Camp Somerset is located approximately 120km north-west of Brisbane on the Eastern side of Lake *Somerset*. One and a half hours easy driving from Brisbane. This beautiful 1000 acre property sides onto 3 kilometres of Somerset Dam waterfront.

The complex boasts a central complex with industrial kitchen and seating for 200 people.



The Cabins at Camp Somerset are modern, functional and are easily accessible from all facilities. Each cabin has a veranda overlooking the bush - perfect for some quiet reflective time.



Must bring!

- ⇒ Sheets & blankets or sleeping bag,
- ⇒ Pillow & pillowcase,
- ⇒ Cots for young children (If you have small children don't forget to bring your baby monitor - No phone reception or Wi-Fi),
- ⇒ Togs, swimsuit, or bathers (no nudies!),
- ⇒ Sunscreen and hat,
- ⇒ Towels (bath & swimming),
- ⇒ Casual clothes suitable for outdoor activities, covered shoes,
- ⇒ Torch; insect repellent; folding chair for veranda,

Each cabin has a basic kitchen (jug, cook-top, fridge, microwave) – but it has no cutlery or crockery. If you might like to make tea/coffee in your cabin, you'll need to bring it with you plus a mug and a spoon.

A sense of fun!

The closest small shop is about 15km away (and not always open) – so don't forget anything!

Camp Somerset has little to no phone reception and no Wi-Fi.

Sports equipment for the following options:

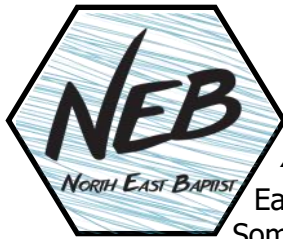

Accommodation

Each of the cabins at Camp Somerset sleep 10 persons. The Bunk Room contains four double bunks, with a separate room providing 2 Single Beds. Each Cabin has it's own kitchenette, covered veranda and bathroom.

Generally we try to fit 2 families in each cabin but we need to fill as many beds as possible. Who would you like to share with?

There will be one men's and one women's dormitory cabin for single men or women.

Camping (no power) is also available. Amenities near the campsite area are available with toilets and hot showers.

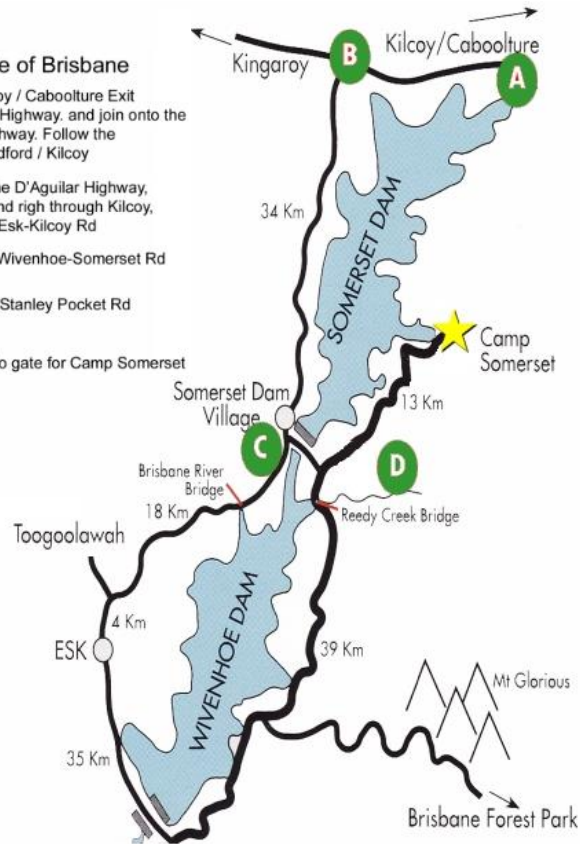

Take the Kilcoy / Caboolture Exit off the Bruce Highway, and join onto the D'Aguiar Highway. Follow the signs to Woodford / Kilcoy
- B** After follow the D'Aguiar Highway, veering left and right through Kilcoy, Turn left into Esk-Kilcoy Rd
- C** Turn left into Wivenhoe-Somerset Rd
- D** Turn left into Stanley Pocket Rd
